# Meeting on Rare Bone Diseases

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## Submission of abstracts – Oral communications

For the 2020 meeting, we will have 3 oral communications sessions selected within the submitted abstracts. The purpose of these sessions is the presentation of studies carried out at the local, national or international level and of clinical or case studies.

We specifically stimulate the submission of collaborative works between Portuguese/Iberian institutions. As much as possible, the works should reflect a multidisciplinary and holistic approach.

In accordance to the scientific program, this year we will have one oral communications session with the theme prenatal diagnosis (Friday morning); one session dedicated to osteogenesis imperfecta and bone fragility (Saturday morning); and one general session for other subjects.

For the submission, an email should be sent to [sbsousa@chuc.min-saude.pt](mailto:sbsousa@chuc.min-saude.pt) **before 27th April 2020 11pm**, with an attached document with the abstract in **English and with format and information indicated below**. You should receive an email confirming the reception of the abstract within 24h. If this does not happen, please contact the secretariat. We will try to accommodate the maximum of presentations but the final reply confirming or not its acceptance will be sent by email before 4th of May. Besides the quality of the work, the selection will also take in consideration the date and order of abstract submission. There will be only a digital version of the abstracts book and there will be no poster presentations. Certificates related to each oral communication will be given.

**In parallel to the submission email, the presenting author is required to register in the meeting indicating at the online registration form the specific work that was submitted.**

Presentations can be made in Portuguese, Spanish or English, but the powerpoint slides should be in English.
